**Job Summary:** The School Nurse is expected to work closely with the school doctor, the other

school nurse(s) and other relevant school personnel to create a learning environment that meets the physical, mental and emotional needs of students. The primary responsibility is to provide nursing care and health counselling to students and parents and to assist the school doctor in carrying out the

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITY AREAS**

The School Nurse is expected to:

- Attend to all accidents and illnesses which occur during her duty with follow-up/referral
- To refer students for medical treatment when required with necessary documentation
- To keep accurate records of all incidents and make these records available to the Medical Team
- To maintain all Sports and Trip First Aid Kits that are issued to Travel Activities and follow-up when not returned
- Maintaining the medical office and equipment (cleansing, refilling, expiration date checks, etc)
- To collate and file hard copies of medical records
- To work collaboratively with all staff providing health services (school doctor, day school nurse, Health and Safety officer, Safety Coordinator) for students and staff
- Updating and administering electronic records
- Participation in health related meetings (e.g. Catering Committee Meeting) if requested
- To provide information/assistance to the School Doctor and School Nurse
- Cover for the day school nurse, when possible
- To be in attendance, as requested and if available, at campus sports event

#### General

The School Nurse is expected to:

- Support community related activities in the promotion of the 'life of the school'.
- Provide support for other activities as deemed appropriate by the Director within the scope of responsibilities as School Nurse.
- Any other duties that may, from time to time, reasonably be required within the general level of responsibility of the post.

## **Review**

This Job Description will be reviewed as part of the School's Appraisal Process. It may also be reviewed by mutual agreement outside such a cycle at the request of either the Director or the post holder.
